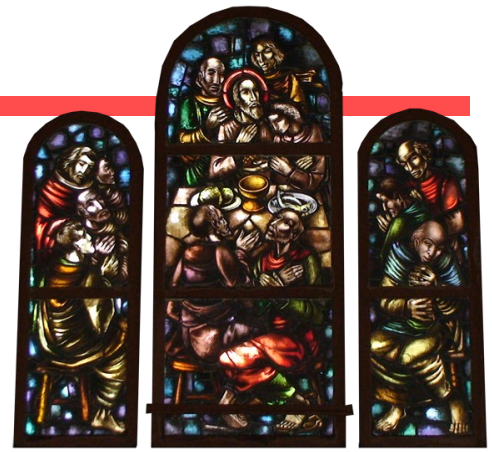

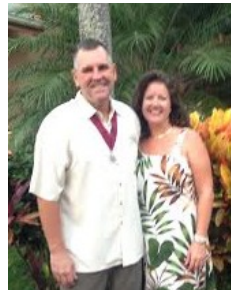

### Lait from St. Mary's serve in the mission fields abroad



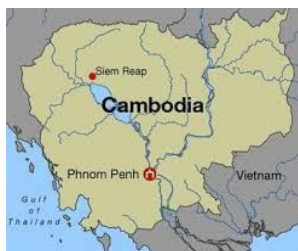
Paul and Marian Eivins

Paul and Marian Eivins are ready to serve. This November they will be traveling to Phnom Penh, Cambodia. Traveling with a Hawaiian team of 15-20 Christian men and woman, they will provide medical and dental care for the impoverished while assisting local pastors and community leaders evangelistically where less than 2% of the population has heard the Good News.

Specifically, Paul will be working in triage and Marian will work in a capacity of children's evangelism, prayer and healing.

It will be the first mission trip together for Paul and Marian. Paul has served in Cambodia before as well as Honduras and Guatemala. Marian taught in Guatemala twice before she met Paul.

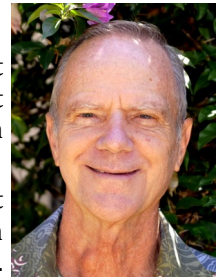

Hugh Kaiser joined St Mary's Episcopal Church December 1984. Fr. Doug McGlynn was the priest.



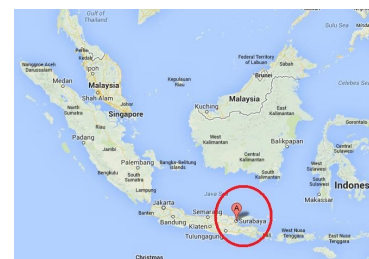

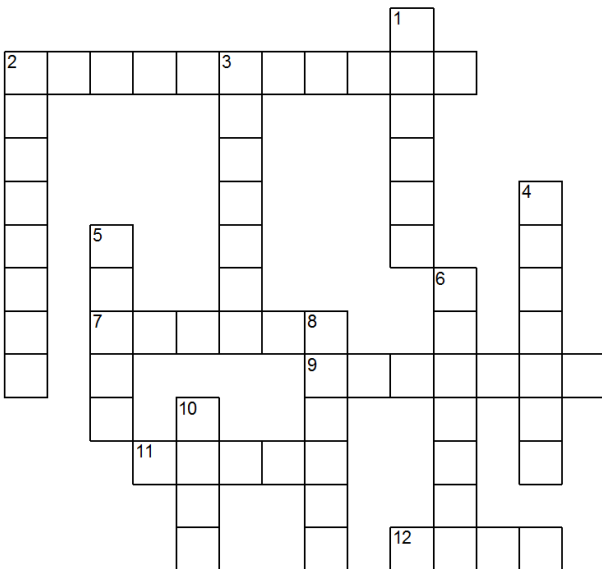
