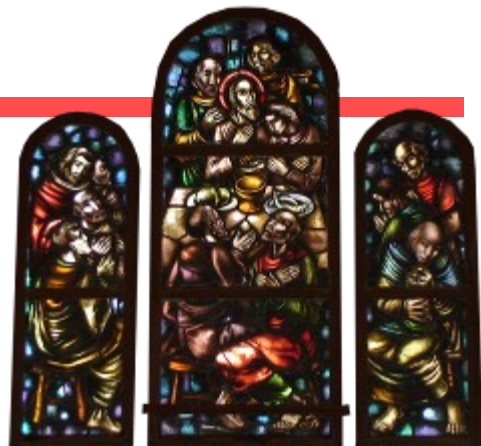

"John was Love"

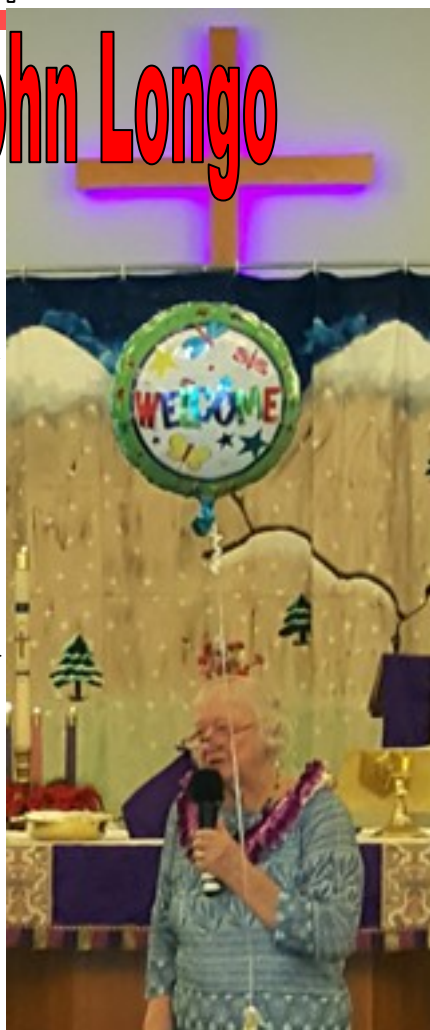
A Thanksgiving for the Life and Ministry of The Reverend John Longo was celebrated Sunday December 18th.

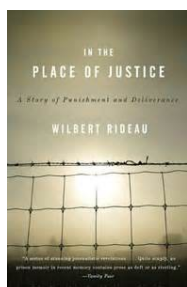

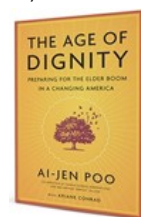
