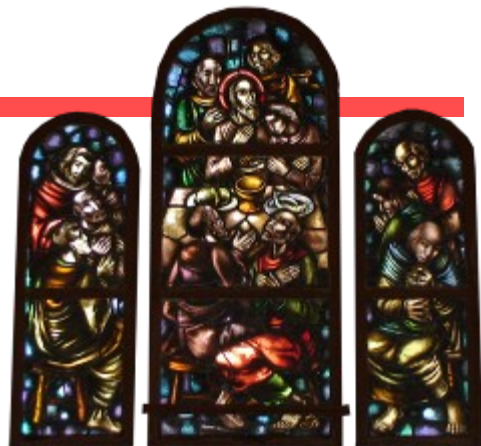

Soldier Chapel is getting a new roof.


Construction began December 22 and is slated to be completed January 6th. No parking permitted behind and along Soldier Chapel as the roofing crew is working Tuesday through Saturday.
