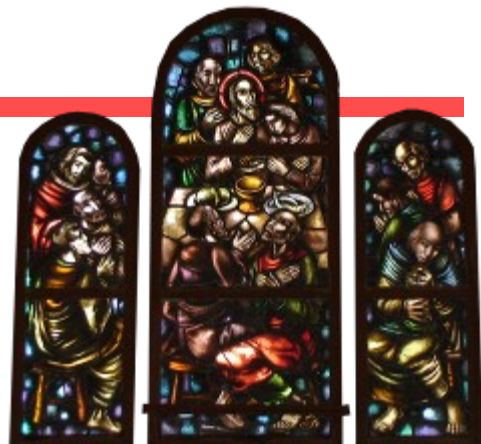

Below: Providers from a local Native Agency are present to assist the needy during Food Pantry hours.

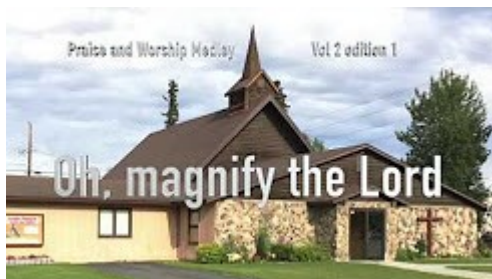


Words from Fr. Davd Blanchett

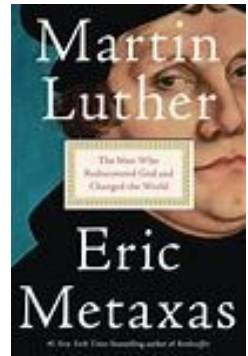

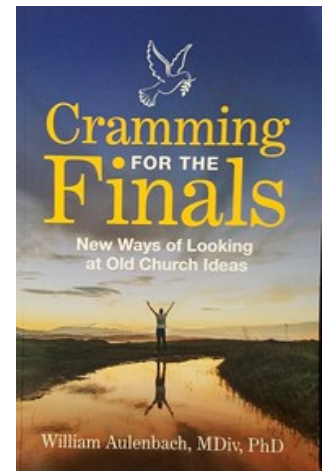
