

Words from the Committee

The next meeting of the Search Committee is tentatively scheduled for June 16. Members of the committee are drafting parts of the profile based on their personal experience as members of St. Mary's for several decades, also the information gathered during the April 28 Parish Meeting hosted by Rev. Sandy Graham. Following one of his suggestions, the intent is "to choose one 'main' writer, to whom is given raw data/simple writing on each of the subjects by members



St. Mary's was built in 1886 as a Parish church and as the pro-cathedral for the Diocese of Auckland.


In 1973 the first half of the new Holy Trinity Cathedral was completed, dedicated and occupied as the Catherdral of Auckland.

In 1982, **St. Mary's** was moved in one piece from across the road to its present position, it is now incorporated as past of the cathedral complex.

St. Mary's is regarded as one of the finest wooden gothic buildings in the world.
