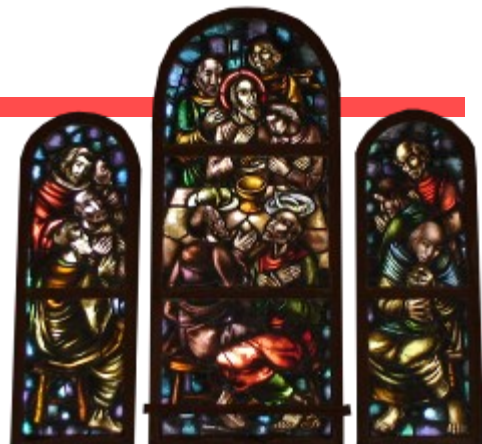

Words from the Committee

The next meeting of the Search Committee is tentatively scheduled for June 16. Members of the committee are drafting parts of the profile based on their personal experience as members of St. Mary's for several decades, also the information gathered during the April 28 Parish Meeting hosted by Rev. Sandy Graham. Following one of his suggestions, the intent is "to choose one 'main' writer, to whom is given raw data/simple writing on each of the subjects by members of the committee, and that writer then gives the profile 'one voice' by writing in their own style." Tatjana Johnson has been asked to be our "main" writer. She has a target date of June 16 to consolidate the data and have a first draft available for review and comment by the Search Committee.



Bishop Fitzpatrick met informally with all members of the congregation in the Gathering Room after service of his annual visitation on May 19th. He emphasized the need to use as many photographs as possible to make our profile more effective in attracting a Rector who will best fit our community. 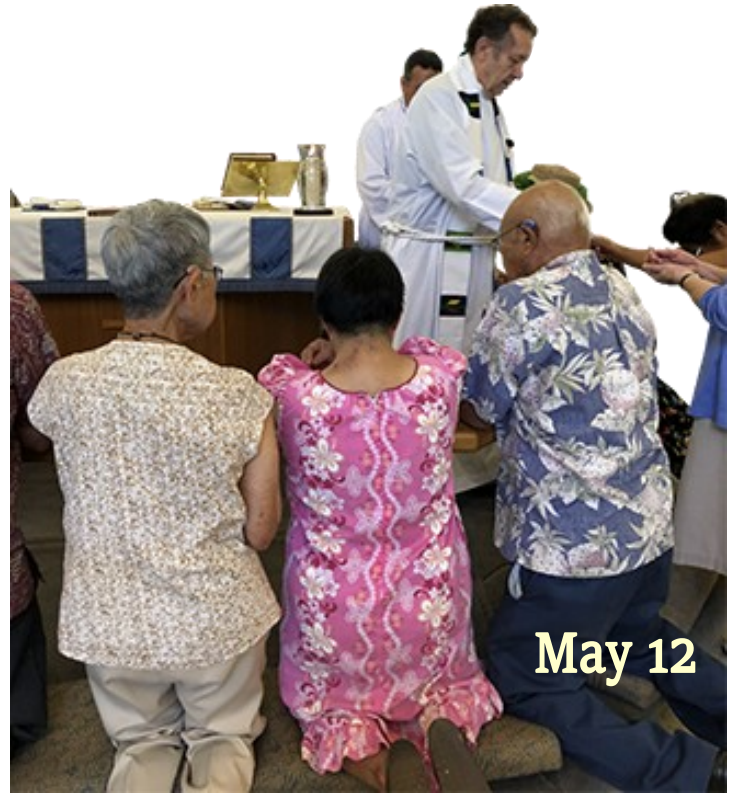

St. Mary's was built in 1886 as a Parish church and as the pro-cathedral for the Diocese of Auckland.

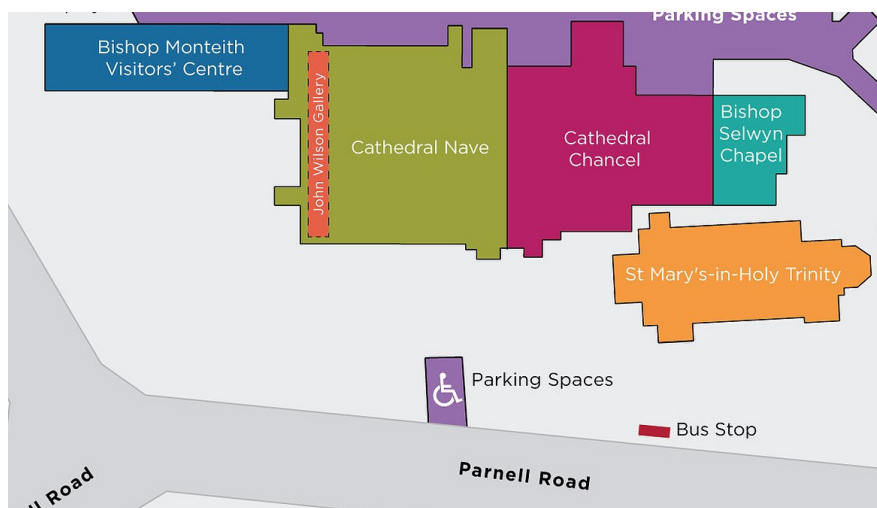
In 1973 the first half of the new Holy Trinity Cathedral was completed, dedicated and occupied as the Cathedral of Auckland.

In 1982, **St. Mary's** was moved in one piece from across the road to its present position, it is now incorporated as part of the cathedral complex.

St. Mary's is regarded as one of the finest wooden gothic buildings in the world.
